PARISH TO HOLD SPECIAL NOVEMBER SERVICES

Holy Trinity Anglican Church in Fairfield will hold several special services prior to the coming of the Advent Church season which begins in December.

On the day before Thanksgiving, the parish will hold a special Thanksgiving Eve-Evening Prayer service for families on Wednesday November 21st at 7:00 PM. Friends, neighbors and families are invited to attend.

The parish will also celebrate the Feast Day of St. Andrew on Friday November 30th at 5:00 PM. The Mass will be from the Scottish Prayer Book of 1637 and will include the traditional "Kirk'n of the Tartan." Anyone of Scottish Heritage, or who enjoys Scottish tradition, is invited to attend. The Very Rev. Lester E. York, Dean of St. Paul's Cathedral in Portland will be guest celebrant.

The parish is an orthodox Anglican Parish of the Anglican Church in America, part of the worldwide Traditional Anglican Communion with members in 44 countries. The Church has continued its historic practice and worship based on the orthodox theology of the historic Church of England in obedience to scripture and the three orthodox creeds of Christendom.

The Church worships at the historic Asa Bates Chapel at 2 Ten Lots Road in Fairfield. The weekly Sunday Service is at 10:00 AM. The Rev. Mr. Jeffrey Monroe is Pastor.
