HOLY TRINITY TO HOLD TRADITIONAL SERVICE OF LESSONS AND CAROLS

Holy Trinity Anglican Church in Fairfield will hold a traditional **SERVICE OF LESSONS AND CAROLS** based on the program of King's College Chapel in England on Sunday, December 16th. The event will begin with an English Tea at 4:00 PM followed by the service at 6:30 PM. Everyone is invited to this celebration service which contains passages from Holy Scripture and traditional music. The historic Asa Bates Chapel will also be open for public viewing prior to the service during the tea.

The parish is an orthodox Anglican Parish of the Anglican Church in America, part of the worldwide Traditional Anglican Communion with members in 44 countries. The Church has continued its historic practice and worship based on the orthodox theology of the historic Church of England in obedience to scripture and the three orthodox creeds of Christendom.
